
## **10501S or L TURNING SHEET**



### <u>Key Features</u>

- The Turning Sheet is used in conjunction with a mechanical hoist to turn heavy patients from side to side.
- Hoists with standard spreader bars can only be used.
- This turn sheet can be used alone or with a fitted mattress slide sheet (11701, 11705), to make turns easier, and with a sheet on top for patient comfort.
- The four side handles have three coloured loop choices to attach to the lifter hooks.
- Turn sheet can be left under patient and kept from sliding down the bed with straps threaded through eyelets and back around the bed frame.

### Instructions to turn patient onto side.

- 1. Place Turn Sheet on bed under patient with handles protruding either side. (If Turn sheet is already under patient, ensure black holding straps, at top of bed, are unclipped before turning).
- 2. Make sure bed brakes are on and raise both bed rails.
- 3. Patient should be in centre of bed.
- 4. Bring lifter to the opposite side of the bed to which you want the patient to face after turning.
- 5. Bed may need to be lowered depending on how high the lifter can go and which strap attachment is chosen.
- 6. Position patients arms and legs as for a normal log roll.
- 7. Attach the two side straps to lifter spreader bar ensuring same coloured strap is used
- 8. Start slowly raising the lifter boom and walk the lifter backwards (this will keep the patient in the middle of the bed), the patient will turn onto their side looking away from the lifter.
- 9. Second carer should make sure the sheet remains flat and crease free on the side the patient is turning too.
- 10. At completion of turn the sheet can be spread out and secured to the top of the bed using the straps threaded through the eyelets.
